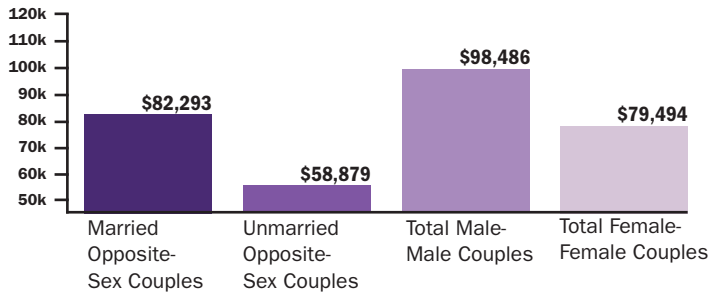


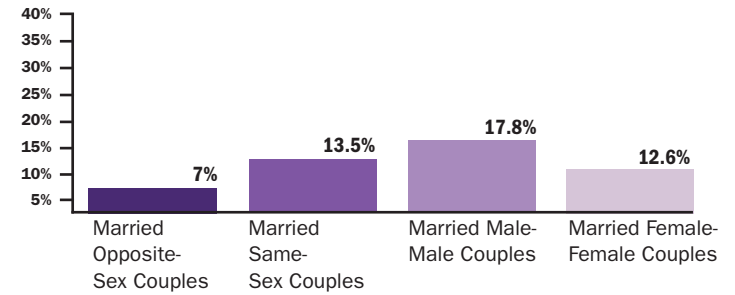

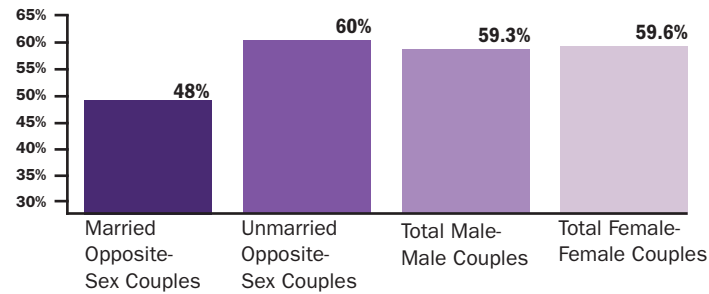
Median Household Income



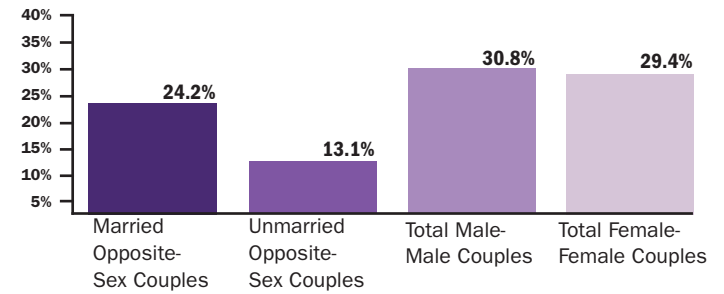
Percent of Couples Interracial



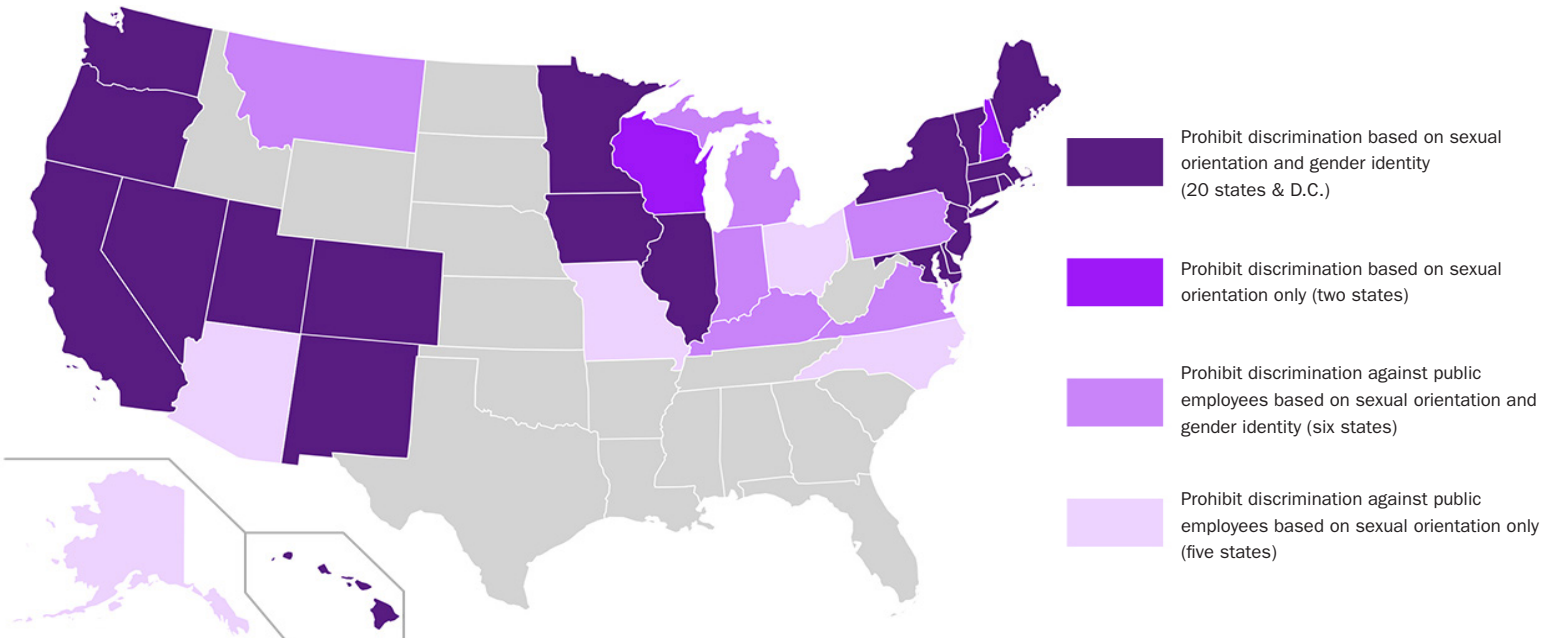
Employment Status: Both Partners Employed
